

Skit Ideas to Illustrate the GS Laws

After you act out the scenario, tell us which of the GS law(s) you are illustrating.

1. You are the leader of a Brownie Troop. You are trying to get the girls organized into a Brownie Circle, but everyone is either running around chasing each other or arguing about something that happened during lunchtime.
2. You are the Leader of an older Brownie Troop. You are discussing which council camping trip to go on. There is one girl in the group who insists on talking above everyone else. Some of the girls have not had a chance to give their opinion.
3. You're a Brownie, age 8. You are on a hike with your troop. Everyone has packed their backpack with a snack, drink, poncho and sit-upon. Your best friend has just thrown her breakfast bar wrapper on the forest floor.
4. You are one of a group of middle school girls having a conversation at the lunch table. One of the girls just spilled her milk all over her jeans. You begin to laugh at her; she's about to cry.
5. You are in 6th grade. One of your best friends has just gotten her Biology test back and she has done poorly. She is worried about her parent's reaction.
6. You are 9 years old. You have 2 younger siblings. Mom is always busy with them and you often feel left out. You notice that your 6 year old brother has left a mess in the family room with his toys spread out everywhere and he has spilled a glass of juice. Mom is upstairs with the baby. You know she's going to 'lose it' when she sees what your brother has done.
7. Yesterday while at lunch, one of your friends called a new Chinese girl a bad name. You told your friend that she shouldn't talk that way about anyone. The rest of the group at the table sided with your friend and now none of them will talk to you. You are crying in your room now and your big sister has walked in.
8. Mom has just asked you if you know who took the last ice cream bar which she had been saving for your older brother, since he hasn't had one yet. You're afraid to tell her the truth, because you ate it and it was your third one!
9. Your dad has an office at home and it is often a mess with stacks of used paper everywhere. It drives you mom crazy. He's asked you to help him throw things away.
10. You and your sister share a bathroom at home. Every evening your sister leaves the hot water faucet running in the sink while she uses the shower, just so the water will get warm so she can wash her face. This makes you crazy. What do you do?
11. You're frustrated because your ninth grade math teacher always calls on the boys during class. You've prepared just as hard as the boys and want an opportunity to participate.
12. Your parents don't like your friends. They think they are a bad influence on you. You've known some of them since kindergarten. Your friends sometimes do make bad choices, but you care about them anyway. How can you support your friends AND satisfy your parents?

You feel so stressed out, you're having trouble sleeping. You've done badly on a few tests because of it. You're afraid to tell your parents about your test scores and your sleep problems, because you think it will make things worse.
