



Super Troop Program



Every member of your troop can earn one of our Super Troop Patches if your troop fulfills the following requirements.

Your troop must complete #1-13

1. The troop qualifies for On-Time Registration.
2. 1 or more leader is current in training for Leadership Essentials, First Aid/CPR & Outdoor Skills.
3. Troop participates in **both** Magnut & Cookie Sales.
4. Troop participates in a meeting with a younger or older troop as a mentor/coach.
5. Leaders plan a “Girl-Driven” program, girls make choices about badges/patches, field trips & service projects.
6. Troop does at least **2** Service Projects during the year, including Caroling for Mars.
7. Troop plans & does a Go Green Project like recycling, trash pick-up, or planting flowers.
8. Troop participates in at least **3 Trefoil Events** such as a recruitment event, Fall Go Green Day, Petal/Badge Day, or Father/Mother & Daughter Event.
9. Registered adults assist in a Trefoil Event, such as kitchen help, set up/clean up, flag ceremony, babysitting, event coordinator, etc.
10. At least one troop representative attends 9 out of 10 monthly leader meetings.
11. Troop contributes to the Juliette Low World Friendship Fund.
12. Troop earns a leadership or team-building related patch, pin or badge or does a related activity.
13. Troop holds at least 2 ceremonies within troop meetings during the year including Investiture or Rededication, Girl Scout’s Own or Court of Awards.
14. Troop plans at least 1 event that includes scout families or parent(s).
15. **Troop submits a complete financial report to the Service Team by June 1.**

You must also complete at least 2 of the following:

16. Troop participates in at least one summer meeting or event.
17. Troop participates in at least 1 Council-sponsored event.
18. Troop Leader/Assistant is an active member of Service Team.
19. Troop Leader/Assistant takes an active role in Council such as Trainer or Delegate to the Association or Annual Meetings.
20. Troop sponsors a “bring a friend” troop event, a scout can bring a non-registered girl to discover girl scouting.
21. Troop plans an age specific (i.e. Daisy Petal or Brownie badge) day event.
